Reshuffling of all classes in 2017/18

- Due to students moving in and out of NIS, some classes have become unbalanced in terms of gender and abilities.
- Due to the expansion of the Elementary School next year, all grade levels will have 4 homeroom classes and not 3, like the case is this year in some grade levels.
